We each use an average of **88 GALLONS** of water per day at home.

Turning off the faucet while **brushing your teeth** can save **8 GALLONS** of water.

Turning off the faucet while **washing dishes** can save **10 GALLONS** of water.

Protect Groundwater

Use all natural or nontoxic household cleaners whenever possible.

Properly dispose of potentially toxic substances like chemicals, pharmaceuticals, paint, etc.

Use fewer chemicals around your home and yard.



Small amounts of bleach and chemical cleaners can kill off the good bacteria and hurt your septic system.

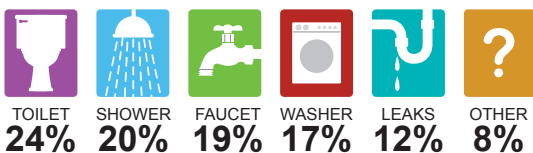
